






# Autumn 1 - Reception

<p><b>Maths</b></p>  <p>In maths we will be using the language of more and less to compare quantities. We will be copying and creating repeating patterns. We will explore numbers 1, 2 and 3 learning how to recognise them represented in different ways.</p>	<p><b>Reading</b></p>  <p>In phonics we will be learning the set 1 sounds. We will practise saying the sound, reading the sound and writing the sound. We will have lots of opportunities to use our Fred Talk to orally blend words for example c-a-t is cat.</p> 	<p><b>Writing</b></p>  <p>In writing we will be making marks and talking about the marks we make. We will be labelling our marks using some of the sounds we have learnt. We will also be practising to write our names.</p>
