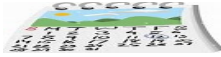

A Message from the Head Teacher

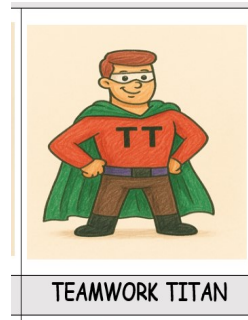
I would like to say a massive thank you to everyone who supported our MacMillan Coffee Morning and cake sale.
